The festival is scheduled to run from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm on Saturday, October 3, 2009 in downtown Columbus.

In order to qualify as a demonstrator you must provide an interactive or spectator vendor booth, displaying how to create one or more products available for sale at the same booth. You may conduct sales; however, you must provide a display booth showing how your product(s) are made. You may also qualify as a demonstrations vendor by providing some other participatory activity (such as story-telling, a puppet show, etc.) even though such activities may not be demonstrating how to create a product. These activities may be carried out in conjunction with the promotion of an organization. No food vendor will be considered a demonstrator.

Please note that all products to be sold by a craft vendor must be handmade by the person(s) selling the craft products.

Please mail this application to the Town of Columbus, PO Box 146, Columbus, NC, 28722, with your check. Upon receiving your application, we will send you a business license. You must keep your business license as proof of your vendor space, and may be asked for proof at the celebration. These fees are **non-refundable** and you are responsible for your own equipment (table, raincover, extension cords, etc.). All spaces must be kept clean during the day and a final clean up must be done before you leave.

If you are a food vendor, and you were required to have a Food Service Establishment permit, the Health Department will check to make sure you are following their guidelines. **Remember, if you don't purchase a food vendor space, you are not allowed to sell food or drinks.**
